

Cleaning the fanhouse - Villa 9000



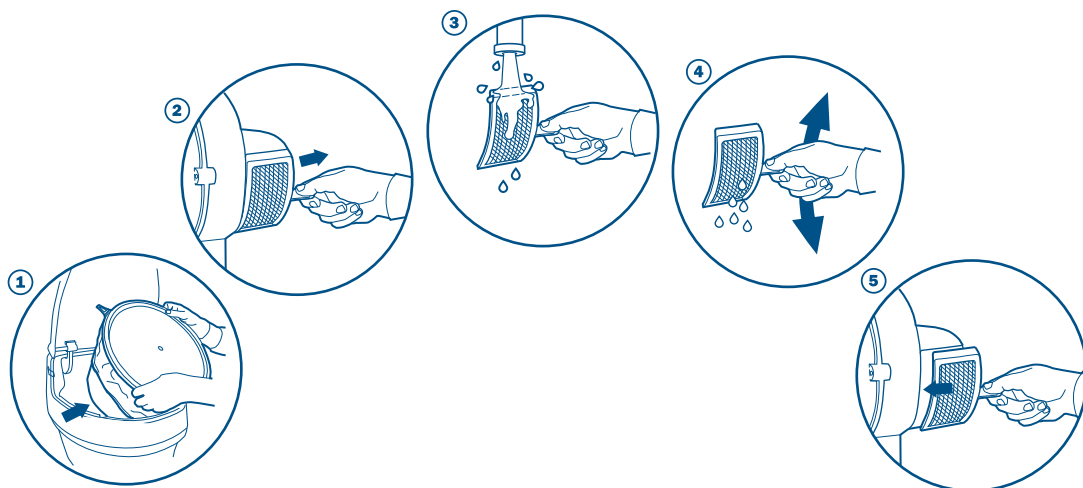
If you are experiencing noise coming from a Villa 9000 toilet, we recommend you to:

- Open the blue fanhouse where the fan is located (assembly instructions available on the next two pages).
- Vacuum internally as dust and insects may lie there and causing the noise from the fan.



Clean the fan blades as well carefully with for example a toothbrush.

We also recommend checking the ventilation tube to ensure that nothing is stuck in there. This could cause imbalance on the fan or making the fan stop completely.

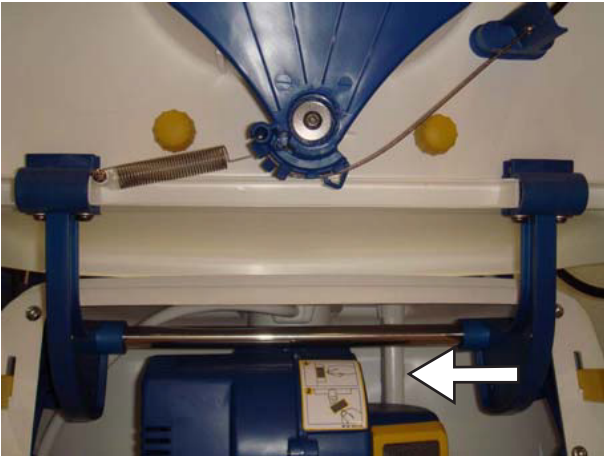


We also recommend that you regularly rinse the filter in the fanhouse with water as illustrated above.

Assembling instruction fanhouse - Villa 9000

NOTE! Turn the power off first

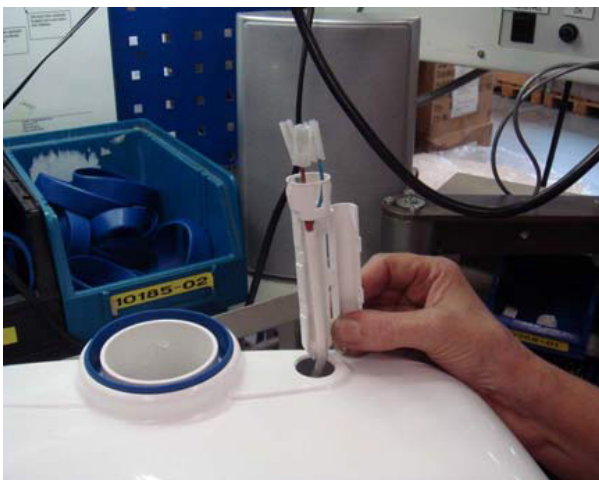


Press the plastic shall through the hole.

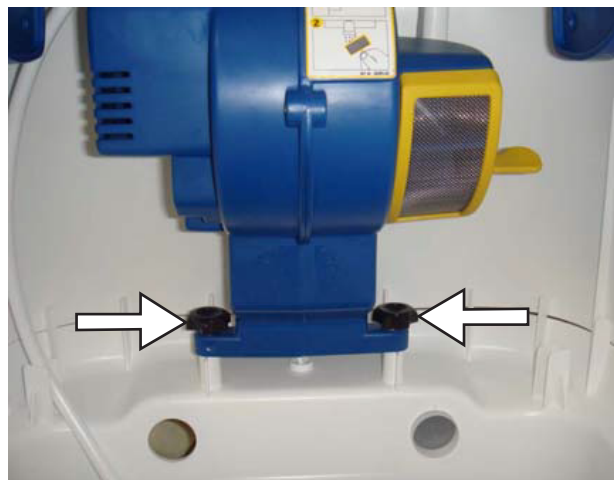


Remove the button and connect as below::

- Red cable against middle pin
- Blue cable against pin "position 2"
- Brown cable against pin "position 1"



Open the plastic shall according to the picture above.

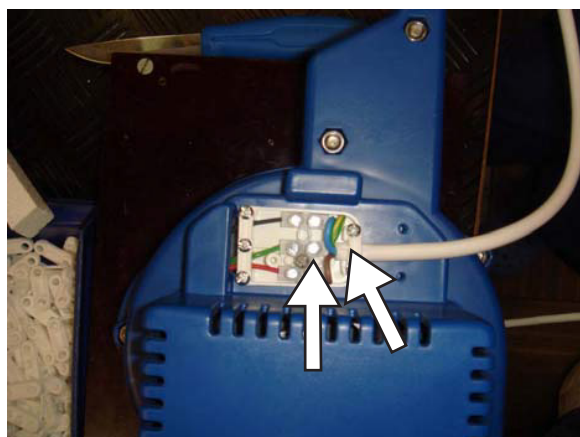


Loose the 2 screws according to the picture above and drag out the fan house.

Loose the cover and connector as illustrated by the arrows above.



Loose the cable as illustrated by the arrows above. Connect as below:

- Earth cable to be connected against earth cable from fan house
- Brown cable to be connected against red cable from fan house
- Blue cable to be connected against black cable from fan house

To assembly the fanhouse back again, follow the instructions and pictures above in reverse order as a guide.
